The following outcomes should be measured and evidenced through session write ups and case studies:-	
Evidence to demonstrate how the provision has supported young pe to build trusted relationship with youth workers, which will provide a protective factor. Offering a counter-narrative and support system that opposes the pull towards serious violence, offending or exploitation.	
Evidence that demonstrates how the young person has accessed provision which has supported social and emotional skills, increasing the young person's ability to cope with aspects of everyday life, whilst building trusted relationship with adults within their community.
